Every Pound Counts

In Lambeth, thousands of older people, ill people and disabled people are missing out on extra cash every day, as are their carers. This is because they do not know about extra benefits they can claim, or they wrongly think they do not qualify, or they give up because they find the benefits system too complicated.

Lambeth Council is working in partnership with Lambeth Primary Care Trust and local advice agencies to give advice on benefits and tax credits to help people claim their full benefit entitlement.

What help will I get?

The Every Pound Counts adviser can:

- Give you free, clear advice about the different benefits you can claim
- Calculate how much extra money you may be able to claim
- Help you to claim the benefits that you are entitled to
- Help you challenge decisions if you have been turned down
- Tell you what will happen to your benefits if your circumstances are about to change

Who this service is for:

Aged 60 or over

Are you or is someone you know or care for, aged 60 and over? Do you need advice about benefits?

Ill or disabled people

Do you have a disability, are experiencing long term ill health or care for such a person?
