Role of the tenancy support service

The tenancy support service ensures that new and existing vulnerable tenants have access to support services which enhance their well being, enable them to continue to live as independently as possible and help them to meet their tenancy obligations.

The tenancy support service has established links and works with social services and health service providers as well as other statutory and voluntary agencies in order to ensure that tenants receive appropriate support to manage their tenancy.

This service offers individual support to a range of people who need additional help to live independently in Lambeth.

About the service

The tenancy support service supports people with multiple needs including:

- Low level mental health
- Alcohol dependency
- Drug dependency
- Physical disability
- Domestic violence
- HIV and AIDS
- Mild learning disability
- Young people at risk
- Young people leaving care (18 years and older)
- Offenders and people at risk of offending
- Vulnerable families

They offer support with the following:

- Establishing and managing tenancies
- Welfare benefits and maximising income

- Independent living skills
- Accessing community facilities
- Training, education and social inclusion
- Accessing appropriate agencies for specialist support
- Accessing local support groups and resources
- Dealing with neighbour disputes
- Independent living skills
