Design Rationale

We have read closely the brief for the refurbishment of Windmill Gardens and have prepared a design that ensures the specification set out within the brief has been followed. We have included the key elements identified following the consultation which was carried out with the community as well as the requirements set out by the council.

We have provided a facility that is robust, supports a high number of users with multiple play activities and is low in maintenance requirements. We noted that the existing roundabout and lorry climber were to stay in situ and be renovated by a rub down and repaint to restore them to their former glory. All other equipment will be removed.

The play area will be transformed by the inclusion of two new large MPU's which facilitate play for a wide age range of children accommodating a range of abilities with a high number of play activities available.

The J38118A MPU we have proposed is designed for younger children. It is an accessible unit allowing easy access from the ground for children who require greater support in relation to mobility. The wide platform and hand grips give good access onto the unit. An inclined slope leads up to the next platform giving direct access to a double width slide. This means that children can gain support from parents/carers if required. A second bridge leads across to another platform where a second slide provides an egress point for

the unit. The whole structure has multiple opportunities to access and exit using a climbing wall, sliding pole and net. On floor level there is an interactive play panel and cosy play corner under the slide. It ensures that up to 25 children from the age of 2 can play on an engaging and challenging structure.



The MPU proposed for children 7-12. It is a challenging 3 x tower structure that is set at differing heights to facilitate interesting and challenging transitions between the towers. Swinging steps and fixed platforms allow children to select routes according to their own ability. Access onto and off the unit is via a climbing wall, arched climbing net, vertical climbing net and ladder. Exit is via a double width slide. The platform heights range from 1.37m to 1.77m high.



The swings are new providing 4 flats and 3 cradle seats with a Me and You swing which allows an adult to swing opposite a young child providing great interaction during this play experience.



We have created an interactive play zone which features the trampoline forming a central focus with the thermographic games surrounding it. This has been designed so children can take turns to bounce



whilst the other children participate in activities circling the trampoline such as hopping balancing etc. A fun way to play and keep fit and active

An additional seesaw is installed adjacent to the toddler MPU.

The request to find shelter without a solid roof offering shade proved difficult and would have taken a large amount of the budget thereby reducing the play value provided. We have therefore proposed a sheltered seating area in front of the existing high wall. This gives perfect shade and we have denoted this space with some further graphics and 2 x new picnic table to allow visitors to benefit from shade when required as their children play.

Rubber surfacing has been overlaid and extended beyond their current extremity to avoid a sharp change in level. The graduated ramped edge ensure access for all. The colours of the wear pads are muted using a combination of reds and greens

New benches have been provided as requested. We hope you like the design and that our illustrations help you visualise the new look we can bring to Windmill Gardens

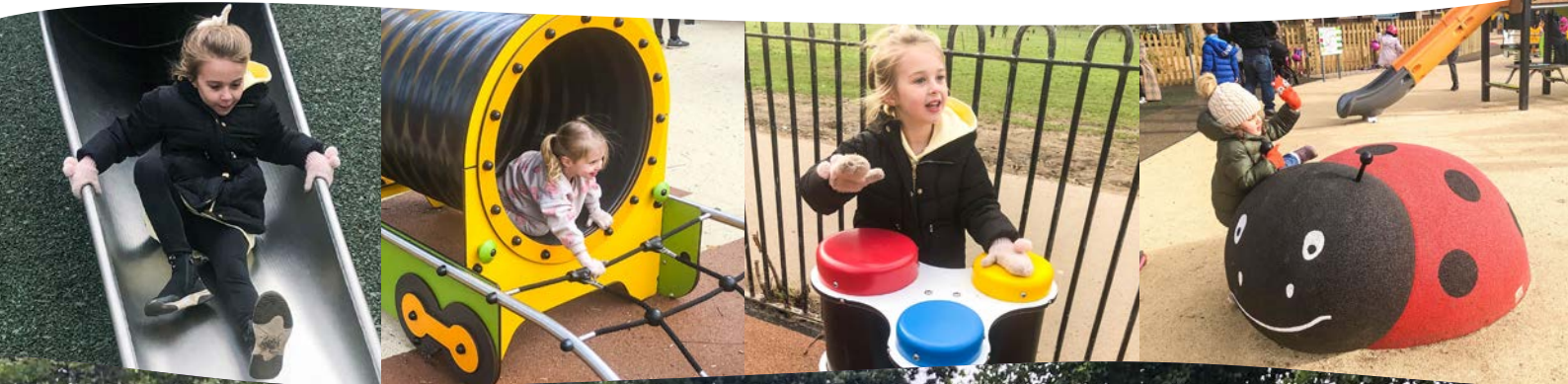

Project Story: Located two miles from the River Thames, the Clapham Common play area is a popular open space in south London. The project brief was to transform the old, dated play area into a vibrant space for local families and their children so they can benefit from a fully inclusive, innovative play experience that caters to all ages and abilities using durable materials.

The innovative design proposed by Proludic achieved a Gold PIPA (Plan Inclusive Play Areas) award, which is a first in the London Borough of Lambeth. The design included a train with a station hut ideal for role play and a sensory sound area. Children can wander around the playground and encounter a giant ladybird and rainbow on the sensory pathways constructed from different materials to create an engaging play journey.

Three large Multiplay Units were selected, along with various swings specifically intended to accommodate the high footfall of visitors aged from toddler, junior through to teenagers ensuring they can play together.

Description

Diabolo is Proludic UK's all in 1 multiplay solution that serves as an ideal centre piece for any play area. All of the classic play functions can be found in Diabolo in order to engage both younger and older children.

Climbing Net - Nearly all children love to climb on nets and in this case alternative rope challenges are available for the different ability levels. For younger users the net can be easily accessed from both ground level or via the step formed by the especially designed stainless steel frame. More advanced users may wish to climb to the top of the net at 2m high and negotiate a route over to the other side of the net, before accessing one of the platforms.

Slide Height 1.17m - The slide enables users to experience the ever popular pleasure of sliding down to the ground from platforms located at a height of 1.17 metres. A protective bar at the top of the slide prevents any accidental falls, as well as providing a support for users as they begin their descent.

Pachinko Play Panel - The yellow disc is dropped from the top of the panel and randomly falls down into one of the three different values located at the bottom of the panel. The game can be played alone or against other users to see who can score the highest number of points with three goes. Not only is it a fun game but it also provides children with the opportunity to discover the basic principles of gravitational forces.

Climbing Wall - Provides an alternative route to the 1.17m platform. The different coloured climbing holds give a decorative appeal, as well as allowing other users to be able to offer advice as to the best hold on which to place a hand or foot in order to advance upwards.

The seat found on the underside of the slide allows children to socialise or simply take a break in the shade. It can be used as a seat, play table or hideout for those children that appreciate some time alone, away from the hustle and bustle of the playground environment.

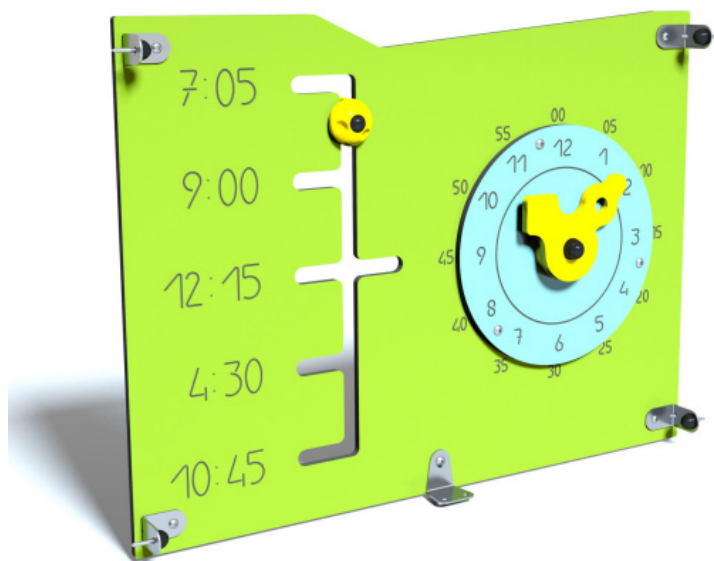

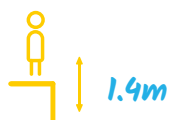

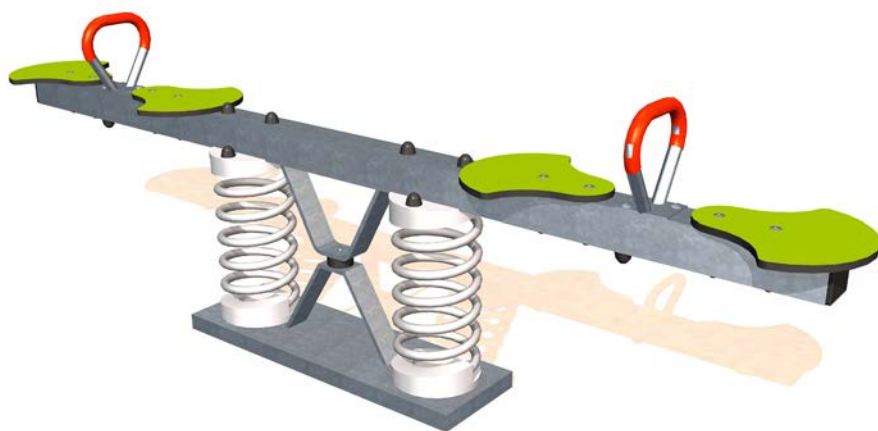

Description

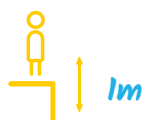

Description

Trampolines are simple to use and open to all children. They develop motor skills, muscle strength, co-ordination and balance. In the air, children become aware of how their body feels in space and can improve their posture.

On the ground-level mat, children in a wheelchair can position themselves in the centre and, with the help of an accompanying adult, gently experience the sensation of bouncing. Trampolines provide a unique play experience for children and offer a sensation that isn't generally found in their daily activities.

The trampoline is suitable for one user with the exception of wheelchair use in which case two people are permitted (the wheelchair user and an additional person to offer support).

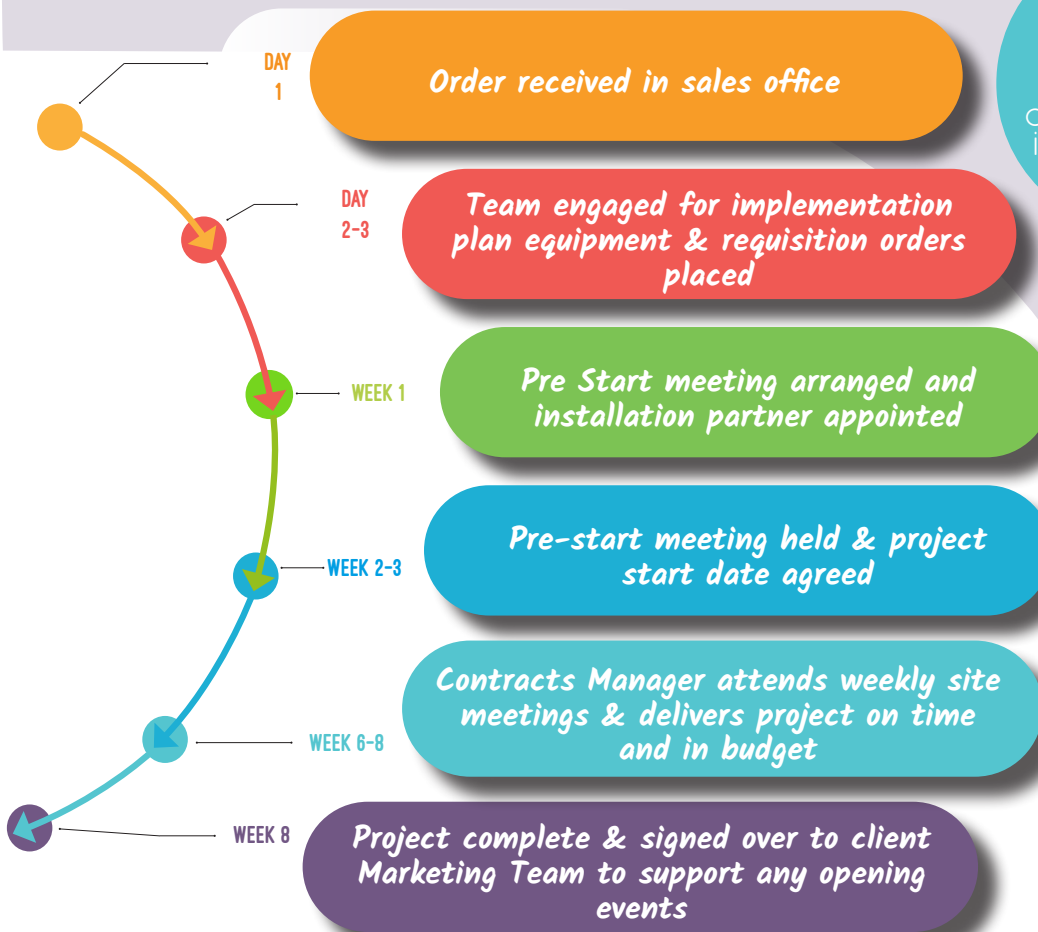

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Whole Life Costs

The typical lifetime of a play area is 20 years (due to dilapidation, material developments, fashion etc.), our 25-year warranty exceeds these expectations and others that may claim lifetime warranties.

Please find below an indicative cost for the annual maintenance cost for the play area, please note these calculations are subject to:-

- How often the equipment is used
- How well the equipment is looked after
- How regular the playground is inspected and maintained

1-2 years – covered under warranty
 3-5 years – 1% of the overall quote total
 5-10 years – 2% of the overall quote total
 10-15 years – 3% of the overall quote total

All our parts are guaranteed for two years (this covers failure due to design, material or manufacturing fault).

 **Across 9 Basildon play areas installed by Proludic, Basildon BC have purchased £1400 of spare parts over 9 years – that's only £155 per year, an average of approx. £17 per site.**

Maintenance Schedules

Since the European safety standards were issued in 1998, the obligations to be met by the operating entity & the equipment supplier have been clearly defined in the form of the normative texts EN1176-1 & EN1176-7. The latter determines various checks to be made at specific intervals. These intervals are given for information purposes only; they will be adapted to suit the final design and handed to you as part of our site handover package.

Monthly

- Routine inspection to identify the risk stemming from acts of vandalism, use or specific weather conditions
- Ensure all fixing are securely fastened
- Check for missing or broken parts
- Ensure that protective covers are in place

Quarterly

- Functional check to make sure that the equipment, or the part concerned is operating correctly
- Check all fixings
- Inspect wear levels (flooring, bars, chains, cables etc)

Yearly

- Inspect the anchoring systems
- Clean thoroughly
- Check the condition of the lacquered plates

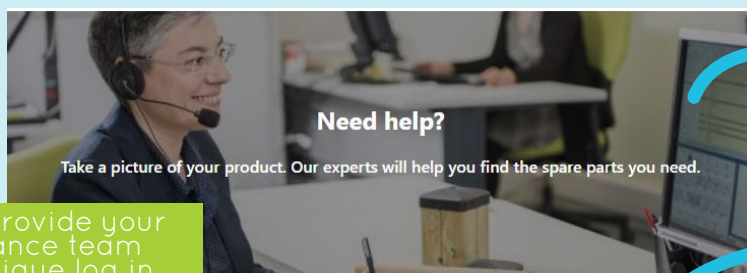

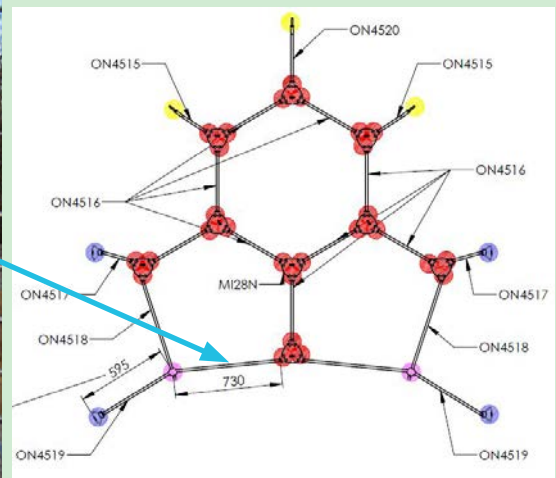


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Examples of ease of replacement / repair

The fixings for the elements were reusable providing further cost savings to the client.
